


The shaded fuelbreak is used in heavily forested areas where it is not environmentally practical nor desirable to clear a fuelbreak through the stand or construct a roadway.

## **BEFORE MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES**



Trees are limbed up and down, dead limbs removed. Brush is removed on both sides of the break width. Young trees are thinned out.

The fuelbreak should visually transition from the understory to some brush islands to brush. Maintain an effective 100- to-300 foot width.
