

B-9	93.59	48' West of Old Glenn Highway, 193' South of Plumbley Road. 1' East of S/E corner of Rusty Dow Substation.
B-10	81.79	39' West of Old Glenn Highway opposite intersection McKechnie Road (North Loop).
B-11	68.42	42' West of Old Glenn Highway 55' South of intersection to Big Valley Raceway.

B-13	51.79	54' East of Old Glenn Highway opposite driveway of James Conway. (Near Township line between T16N and T17N).
B-14	86.48	28' South of Bodenburg Loop South 0.5 miles West of Old Glenn Highway. 3' West of power pole #B101 10W.
B-15	91.10	41' South of Plumbley Road 55' East of Bodenburg Creek. 3' West of power pole #B101 10E.
B-16	77.17	52' Northwest of Section Corner common to Sections 19, 30, 24, and 25. 2' S/E of bearing trees.
H-87	232.34	U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey Brass Cap Monument 11' North of S/W corner of the fenced parking lot of M.E.A. 1964.
B-101	59.98	Corps of Engineers Brass Cap Monument set in concrete on the S/E abutment of the Old Knik River Bridge.
B-0	205.17	"+" on N/W abutment of Matanuska River Bridge l mile East of Palmer.



Bench marks are 3½" aluminum caps on 5/8" aluminum rod driven to refusal. Bench marks are guarded by a red steel white-topped fence post. All bench marks set in 1980. Bench mark B-1 was reset in 1984.
