Project Schedule

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) is preparing the Sub-Area Solutions Studies (SASS) to improve its current transportation network. It will recommend targeted investments to develop new or upgrade existing arterial and collector roads in four growing sub-areas. SASS will identify both road infrastructure improvements and complementary noninfrastructure policies.

- 1. University Medical District (UMED)
- 3. Bogard Seldon Corridor
- 4. Knik Goose Bay-Big Lake
- 2. Fishhook Triangle

Recommendations will align with the MSB Assembly's 2023-2028 Strategic Plan's **Vision, Mission**, and **Values**.


