Fuller Lake - Lake Management Plan: The Borough Planning Department received a valid petition from the residents of Fuller Lake to start the Lake Management Plan (LMP) process. On June 24, 2024, the petition was validated, and ballots were mailed to all shoreline parcels asking residents to provide their preference for or against an LMP. The ballot period closed on September 13, 2024, and the final ballot count returned, with 54% of the residents wanting to move forward with initiating the LMP. The next step in this process is to hold public meetings. This will give the residents of Fuller Lake and the public a chance to meet and discuss current uses and issues on the lake and to learn about the menu of enforceable regulations (MSB Code 17.59) the Borough can include in the plan for Assembly consideration.
