

## Investment Summary 10/01/2024-12/31/2024:

- Total return for the last quarter was 0.17% with interest received of \$1,137,013.
- The average market value for our portfolio was \$221,870,705.
- This quarter there was \$30.7MM Purchased.
- This quarter there was \$17.5MM in Maturities and \$10MM that was Called.
- 33% of the portfolio consists of Callable Bonds.

**4th Quarter 2024 Fish & Wildlife Commission (FWC) Report:** The FWC met three times this quarter. On December 12, 2025, the Commission hosted the annual Fishing Season Summary with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) and the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). Members presented questions and discussed the Chelatna Lake weir project, federal funding, and fisheries-related issues with both ADF&G and NOAA. The FWC continues to evaluate Board of Game proposals and possible Water Body Setback ordinances.
